



Electronic Journal on Christian-Jewish Relations Publishes First Issue

Studies in Christian-Jewish Relations, the new on-line journal published by the Council of Centers on Jewish-Christian Relations (U.S.A.), has posted its first issue. The lead article, by Jesper Svartnik of Lund University, Sweden, is on "Forging an Incarnational Theology Two Score Years after *Nostra Aetate*." Also included are articles on Christology and Christian-Jewish dialogue or interreligious dialogue by Paolo Gamberini, S.J. of the Pontifical Theological Faculty of Southern Italy; Hans Hermann Henrix of the Catholic Academy of the Diocese of Aachen, Germany; Philip A. Cunningham of Boston College; and Christian M. Rutishauser of the Gregorian University, Rome.
