



U.S. Catholic Bishops Publish Texts on “The Bible, the Jews, and the Death of Jesus”;

The Bishops' Committee for Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has published a collection of key documents of Catholic teaching on the Church's relationship to the Jews and its opposition to anti-Semitism. Timed to coincide with the release of the film “The Passion of the Christ,” the volume includes the 1988 ['Criteria for the Evaluation of Dramatizations of the Passion'](#) as well as earlier and later texts, some of which originated in the United States and others from the Vatican and its various offices.
