International Council of Christians and Jews (ICCJ) has announced that its 2008 Annual Conference

will be held June 22-25 in Jerusalem, under the theme "The Contribution of


Jewish-Christian-Muslim Dialogue to Peace-Building in the Middle East." The local host of the

program will be the Centre for Interreligious Encounter with Israel, a program of the Interreligious

Coordinating Council in Israel. Topics to be dealt with will include Theology of the Land, the
influence of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict on Christian-Jewish relations, and the role of
religion in the conflict, as well as religion as a source of reconciliation.
The
venue for the conference will be the Judaean Guest House, a new facility in southern Jerusalem, with
further housing at the Ecumenical Institute for Theological Studies (Tantur). Workshops will be held
in the form of study outings to the sites of programs of interreligious education and
reconciliation. Areas visited will include the Jewish, Christian, and Muslim quarters of the Old
