These contacts plus personal friendships with others in various countries who shared his concerns enabled him to give an international character to the website from the start. It currently has sections in six languages: English, German, French, Spanish, Portuguese, and Russian.

Voll managed and financed the site on his own from 1994 to 2000, when he entrusted it to the [International Council of Christians and Jews](#), though he continued to serve as webmaster until 2004. He is currently in the process of relocating to Toronto, Ontario, Canada.
