Montreal Journal Publishes Special Issue on Jewish-Christian Dialogue

Théologiques, a journal published by the Faculty of Theology and Religious Studies of the University of Montreal, has issued a special double number on the current status and future prospects of Jewish-Christian dialogue. Although most of the articles are in French, four are in English: a paired set of essays on "Imagining the "Other"" by Joan Poulin and Howard S. Joseph, "Dabru Emet: A Contextual Analysis," by Michael Signer; and "Jewish-Christian Dialogue Under the Shadow of the Israeli-Palestinian Conflict," by Gregory Baum.
